



TURNIUM PROVIDES AN UPDATE ON ITS PROPOSAL TO EXTEND THE TERM OF CERTAIN WARRANTS

July 22, 2026 – Vancouver, Canada – **Turnium Technology Group Inc. (TSXV: TTGI) (FSE: E48)** ("TTGI" or the "**Company**"), a global provider of Technology-as-a-Service (TaaS) solutions and channel-driven IT services, provides an update on its application to the TSX Venture Exchange (the "**Exchange**") for the extension of certain of its common share purchase warrants (the "Warrants").

The Company is seeking an extension to the terms of the warrants as originally issued per the terms below:

- 30,210,000 warrants issued on August 1, 2023 with an expiration date of August 1, 2026 at \$0.14/share. The Company wishes to extend these to August 1, 2028;
- 4,790,000 warrants issued on August 22, 2023 with an expiration date of August 22, 2026 at \$0.14/share. There were 200,000 warrants exercised for this issuance in April 2024, with a total of 4,590,000 warrants remaining. The Company wishes to extend these to August 22, 2028; and
- 5,569,652 warrants issued on August 22, 2024 with an expiration date of August 22, 2026 at \$0.105/share. The Company wishes to extend these to August 22, 2028.

The Proposed amendments to the Expiration dates of the warrants are subject to the approval of the Exchange.

All the original Warrant terms remain unchanged. The Company's directors and officers beneficially own, in the aggregate, less than 5% of the total number of Warrants.
